

ORDINANCE NO 633

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE CONSUMPTION OF INTOXICATING LIQUOR IN PUBLIC SPACES; REPEALING ORDINANCES 303, 368, 398, 399, AND OTHER ORDINANCES OR PARTS THEREOF IN CONFLICT

The people of the City of Amity ordain as follows:

Section 1. Definitions.

“Unsealed container” means any bottle, can or other receptacle containing any alcoholic liquor, which has been opened, or a seal broken, or the contents of which have been partially removed. This paragraph does not apply to a wine bottle that has been opened and re-corked in a restaurant.

Section 2. Consumption of Alcoholic Liquors in Public Place Prohibited.

No person shall drink or consume any alcoholic liquor or possess an unsealed container in or upon any street, alley, public grounds or other public place unless such place has been licensed for that purpose by the Oregon Liquor Control Commission.

Section 3. Violations.

The first violation of this ordinance shall be a Class ‘3’ offense. The second violation of this ordinance within a one year period shall be a Class ‘2’ offense. The third and any subsequent violations of this ordinance within a one year period shall be a Class ‘1’ offense.

This ordinance will take effect 30 days from the date of its passage.


