

ORDINANCE NO. 628

AN ORDINANCE CATEGORIZING CIVIL INFRACTIONS FOR THE PURPOSE OF DETERMINING FINES

WHEREAS, the City of Amity City Council desires to establish a uniform method of categorizing infractions of city code for the purpose of determining fines; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to establish common language throughout city ordinances; and

NOW THEREFORE,

THE CITY OF AMITY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Infractions are categorized for the purpose of determining fines in the following categories:

- Class '1'
- Class '2'
- Class '3'
- Class '4'

Section 2: The schedule of fines for each category shall be as follows:

|-----------|--------------------------------|
| Class '1' | \$1,000 - One thousand dollars |
| Class '2' | \$500 - Five hundred dollars |
| Class '3' | \$100 - One hundred dollars |
| Class '4' | \$25 - Twenty-five dollars |

Section 3: Future city ordinances shall utilize these categories when establishing the level of infraction for purposes of determining fines.

This ordinance will take effect 30 days from the date of its passage.


