

ORDINANCE NO 629

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 627 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Amity City Ordinance 627 contains an error in Section 18; and,

WHEREAS, the Amity City Council desires to correct said error;

NOW THEREFORE, the City of Amity ordains as follows:

“Section 18. Civil infraction assessment,” in its entirety, is hereby replaced with the following:

“Section 18. Civil infraction assessment.

A violation of any provision of this ordinance constitutes a Class 4 civil infraction for the first violation and a Class 3 civil infraction for any subsequent violations within a twelve month period. All violations shall be dealt with in accordance with the procedures as otherwise approved by Amity City Ordinance No. 628.”

The Council desires and deems it necessary for the preservation of the health, peace and safety of the City of Amity that this ordinance take effect at once, and therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.


